Successful Fly Tipping Prosecution

Durley Parish Council are pleased to report to residents that Winchester City Council attended Southampton Magistrates Court on 2nd August, 2021 for a case that involved the dumping of rubbish in Netherhill Lane, Durley.

The rubbish that was dumped consisted of household waste, household items, garden waste and assorted bags and wood. The rubbish blocked the road, and was spread for a distance of 100 metres.

A female passed over rubbish to a male who, despite attempts to find him, could not be traced. The female was prosecuted under s34 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 (Duty of Care). She initially pleaded Not Guilty but then changed her plea to Guilty.

Magistrates imposed the following: Fine: £200

Compensation: £300 Costs: £100 contribution Victim Surcharge: £34

TOTAL: £634

Durley Parish Council reports fly tipping along our country lanes and will continue to support Winchester City Council in prosecuting offenders wherever possible.
